## Who are Recipero?

Recipero is a privately owned UK company and the world leader in the collection of information relating to uniquely identifiable, serial-numbered goods.

This information ranges from the identification of the make and model from the serial number, through to a full historic profile of the item's life. This may include reports of loss, theft, insurance or warranty claims, plus details of international restrictions on use, average used value, number of previous owners, and a range of item specific ancillary information.

A variety of organisations ranging from government departments to individual consumers request access to this information on a daily basis to assist them in managing risk around specific decisions. Recipero facilitates this through a series of online search services, making a small charge each time the data is queried.

## Recipero's global solution for a mobile market

Recipero's history is firmly rooted in the UK. However the demand for access to its information is driving it to provide solutions further afield. This demand coupled with the mobile nature of the items Recipero holds data about, has meant it now offers its services in the US, Asian and wider European markets.

### Access via a growing number of devices and applications

Recipero knows that ease of access to its data drives searches and revenues. This is why in many markets it is now possible to check against the data from a range of devices, including hand-held, barcode & RF scanners and smart phones. Additionally major clients can utilise an Application Programming Interface (API) that allows them to check against Recipero's data directly from their EPOS or stock control systems.

### The Green Agenda and the WEEE Directive

The green movement and new legislation means that a huge amount of serial-numbered goods are now being handled by companies and organisations that previously may not had call to consider taking trade-ins or recycling. To protect their employees and reputations they need to ensure that such goods are not stolen and many are turning to Recipero to assist them in this area.

Additionally, working closely with partners Recipero is able to offer some complementary services to large clients that enable them to present unique trade-in scenarios to their own customers.

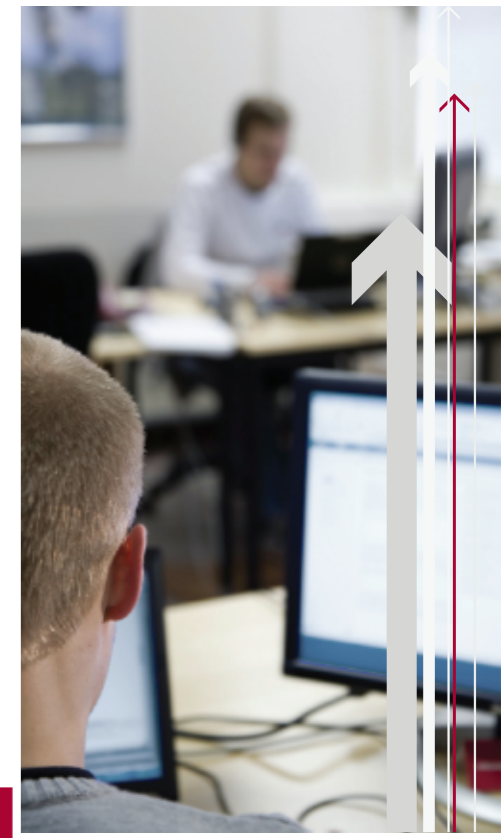

## Recipero data services: Collection, search, decision.

Recipero's services encompass two distinct areas; **data collection** and **data interrogation**.

### Data Collection

As well as gathering data from organisations like the Police, insurance firms, retailers and manufacturers, Recipero also operate Police endorsed data gathering services that collect data directly from businesses and individuals. On the whole Recipero provides free use of its tools that collect data.

### IMMOBILISE

Pre-loss, theft or disaster personal asset registration with over 24 million users integrated directly within the NMPR and CheckMEND services.

### reportMyloss

Law enforcement endorsed system for public reporting of lost property.

### fone ASSIS+

Premium mobile phone registration service that provides 24/7 support and assistance in the event a phone is lost or stolen worldwide.

## Data Interrogation

Recipero's data interrogation products are used by a wide range of organisations that include the Police, HMRC, retailers, insurers, recyclers and individuals. All the search services Recipero provides are concerned with the management of risk when making a specific decision. This decision can be as diverse as whether to buy a used item on eBay to whether to arrest someone in possession of stolen goods.

### CheckMEND

Public, retail and trade access to Recipero's databases to perform due-diligence and risk management prior to purchase of goods.

### NMPR

Dedicated property search system designed to assist law enforcement in the identification of stolen goods.

### Patriot

Online checking against Recipero's databases to reduce risk in fulfilling potentially fraudulent claims.

### Avalon

Mobile phone network checking service to ensure stolen handsets don't work on their networks.

### NEMESIS

Tax agency checking service to ensure legal trading of identifiable goods including identification of tax fraud.
